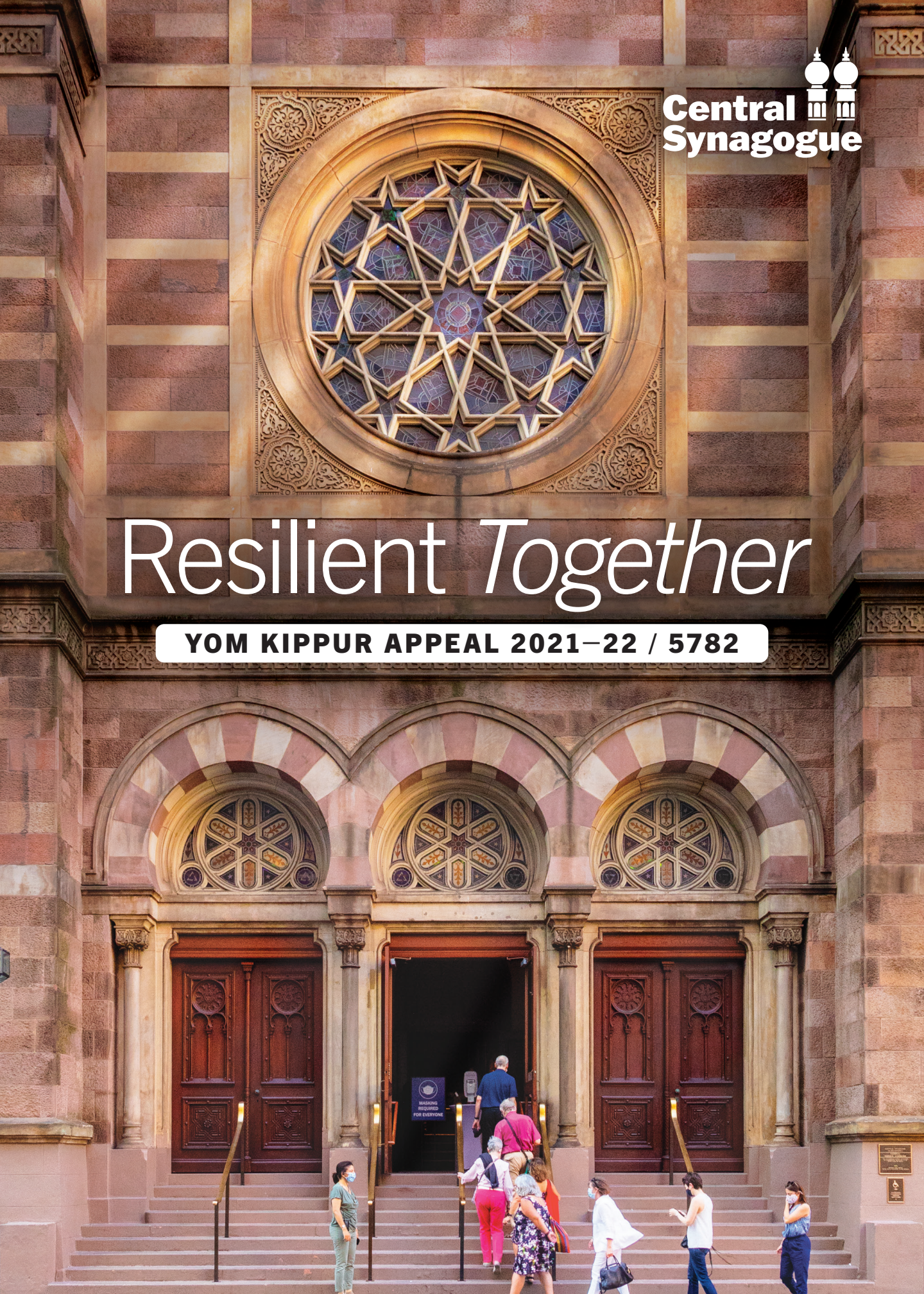

These past 12 months have been even more challenging than the prior six months when our world turned upside down. Through the initial phase of the pandemic, we proved we could move our worship online, make our educational classes virtual, and our life cycle observances remote—all while continuing to imbue these with meaning, inspiration, spirituality, and soul.

When we were called, we answered.

Your sustained support enables us to continue to meet our congregants' needs and gracefully navigate the unpredictable and ongoing complexity of the pandemic. We produced meaningful High Holy Days, reimagined to be all-virtual and brought to your home. Our Clergy led Shabbat services livestreamed from our beautiful Sanctuary, accompanied by incredible musicians and best-in-class streaming capabilities. We enrolled over 650 children in our schools with both virtual and in-person programming and created touchpoints with all of our members, who received calls from congregants and Clergy.

I'd like to take this opportunity to express my gratitude to our COVID Task Force*, which has provided scientific acumen throughout the pandemic. More recently, guided by their expertise, we successfully reopened our doors for a safe return to in-person Shabbat services and brought back life cycle events—celebrations and funerals—to our Sanctuary. And we look forward to being together for the High Holy Days, even as we keep a watchful eye on developments to ensure that our congregants' worship is comfortable and safe. We will, of course, continue to offer virtual worship at the same gold standard level as last year.

Central has been able to adapt to changing circumstances because of your support for the innovation, commitment, and creativity of our beloved Clergy and professional staff. You have helped ensure that our members continue to receive spiritual sustenance, comfort, and connection at a time when our congregation needs it most. As we move into another holiday season filled with uncertainty and immense hope, I know that we all find inspiration in Central's strength and resilience, made possible because of your continued support.

Elevating Our Worship

At the core of Central Synagogue’s worship are our spirited services and warm, welcoming tone that honors the Reform Jewish tradition.

At a time of unprecedented challenge, Central creatively explored innovative ways to provide worship and other programming remotely. We reached members and non-members in 87 countries through our website, Facebook, YouTube, and Jewish Broadcasting Service. Today, Central has the broadest global reach of any Reform Synagogue in the world, sharing our vision for how Judaism can be a profound and positive force for humanity.

This past spring, spurred by the hope offered by the vaccine, Central was able to reopen its Sanctuary doors and to once again stand side-by-side with our members for their personal milestones, from b’nei mitzvah to *yahrzeits*. In May, we installed our Board of Trustees at a special service in our Sanctuary that launched a summer season of in-person Shabbat services after more than a year of being virtual.

Throughout the pandemic, our Clergy has continued to provide deep and meaningful spiritual leadership, creating opportunities for congregants to connect, pray, and sing. This has been a critical source of strength for thousands, whether virtually or in-person. Our exceptional Clergy and music and audiovisual staff are directly sustained by your support and are vital to our members’ singular worship experience.

Fostering Community

At Central, we strive to be an inclusive place that welcomes all people, including those who have been historically marginalized from the Jewish community. We build relationships through our pastoral care, as our Clergy support our members through life challenges and illnesses with love and compassion. Our innovative programs deepen our members’ engagement with Judaism and one another with a depth and breadth of offerings that embrace diverse interests and perspectives.

Our tradition encourages us to seek truth, to question, to learn, to wrestle with contradictions and complexity, to engage with the world around us, and to grow. Central is committed to furthering important conversations about America’s history of racism, the global rise of antisemitism, and the nuances of the conflict in Israel. This past year, Central facilitated discussions and group studies for members, hosting renowned speakers such as Dr. Beverly Daniel Tatum and Reverend Otis Moss. Following the most recent outbreak of violence in Israel, we held insightful conversations with experts Dr. Steven Bayme and Rabbi Dr. Michael Marmor. We heard Jewish and non-Jewish reflections on contemporary life in Israel through our series “Breakfasts With Israeli Women.”

Our sacred mandate to welcome the stranger took on even greater meaning in this time of instability. Our long-running Breakfast Program served over 20,000 hot and nutritious meals. While holidays can be challenging for many—especially during a time of record-breaking unemployment—Central families stepped up to donate food during our Thanksgiving *Tikkun Olam*-a-thon and held a Chanukah gift drive. One hundred of our congregants mentored underserved students at the High School of Art and Design in our neighborhood and helped seniors navigate the college application process. The Jewish value of justice was embodied by the Central in Action leadership team as they continued their efforts toward enacting systemic policy change in New York State focusing on criminal justice reform, while expanding their work on food insecurity, and partnering with Emmaus House of Harlem and Exodus Transitional Community.

We are committed to ensuring that financial need is never a barrier to membership. Because of your support, 20% of our members were able to be part of this community with dues or tuition assistance. Most of our programs continue to be free to all, not just our members, furthering our goal of inclusivity.

ADULT ENGAGEMENT

Throughout a year in which it would have been easy to feel isolated, Central’s learning opportunities ensured members remained connected to Judaism, one another, and our world.

Experts led virtual tours of the old cities of Prague and Jerusalem to the punk-era streets of the Village; talented musicians performed classical and popular favorites live; Jewish chef and African American culinary historian Michael Twitty connected us through food; and the Jewish Women’s Archive reintroduced hundreds of viewers to the stories and contributions of Jewish women often overlooked by history.

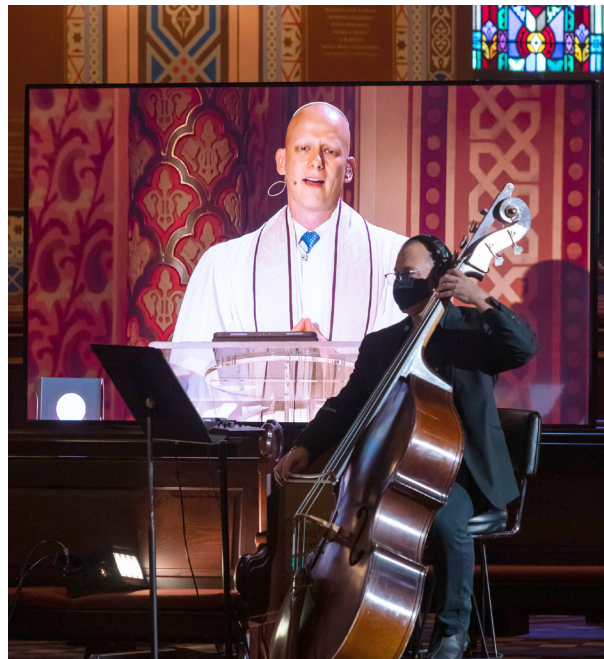

Investing in Our Home

Our home is much more than a brick-and-mortar Sanctuary. It is where and how our community comes together, whether in person or online. Your ongoing support has been vital to elevating and protecting our home, while allowing us to keep pace with the evolving needs of our community in times of crisis.



Our values guide us as we make investment decisions at Central. While many synagogues faced difficult staffing and budget decisions this past year, your support allowed Central to retain maintenance, facilities, and security staff throughout the duration of the pandemic. We are grateful to have them as an integral part of our community. We were also guided by our Jewish value of *pikuach nefesh*—the preservation of life—

as we made significant infrastructure updates to implement necessary COVID protocols. And with antisemitism on the rise, we continue to invest in our security to ensure we remain a safe place for all who walk through our doors.

Our long-term investments in our virtual home also became of paramount importance over the past year. Central first brought our home into your home decades ago when we offered live services by telephone. Yet no one could have predicted the essential role remote access would play this past year for Jews around the world, many of whom faced the prospect of worshipping in isolation for the first time.



We are grateful for your ongoing support, which bolsters our physical and virtual infrastructure and ensures that the next generation will inherit a thriving spiritual home.

Forming Our Future

Our commitment to Jewish education is exemplified in our multigenerational approach to learning, beginning with our youngest members and extending to lifelong engagement. Through our classes and programming, Central provides inspiring opportunities to deepen one's understanding and appreciation for Jewish heritage, culture, and ritual.



Throughout this past year, our May Family Nursery School remained in-person, providing stability and a sense of normalcy for many families. We are grateful for our staff, who are bastions of joy, education and support for our children's social-emotional needs alongside Jewish learning and celebration.

Our Lese Center for Living Judaism (LCLJ), with six full-time educators, encourages our students

to celebrate their own identity, think critically, and help bring positive change in the world. We prioritize support for all, regardless of learning differences, with dedicated staff who continue to transform the way we think about teaching to the 'special needs' of every child.

Our Center for Exploring Judaism (CEJ) continued to offer intensive learning and counseling for anyone wishing to explore Jewish life. During the past year, CEJ's virtual semester-long courses reached hundreds, including many newcomers to Judaism across the globe.

Beyond our walls, we continued to play a leading role in the Reform movement. For years, non-members across the country and around the world have asked for affiliation with Central Synagogue, often alongside membership in their local congregations. This summer, in response to this demand, Central created a pilot online community, *The Neighborhood*, and welcomed close to 400 Neighbors within days of the launch.

We invest in future generations of Jews and Jewish leaders. We point with pride to the successes of our LCLJ full-time educators, many of whom went on to leadership positions in Jewish communal organizations or enrolled in our seminaries.

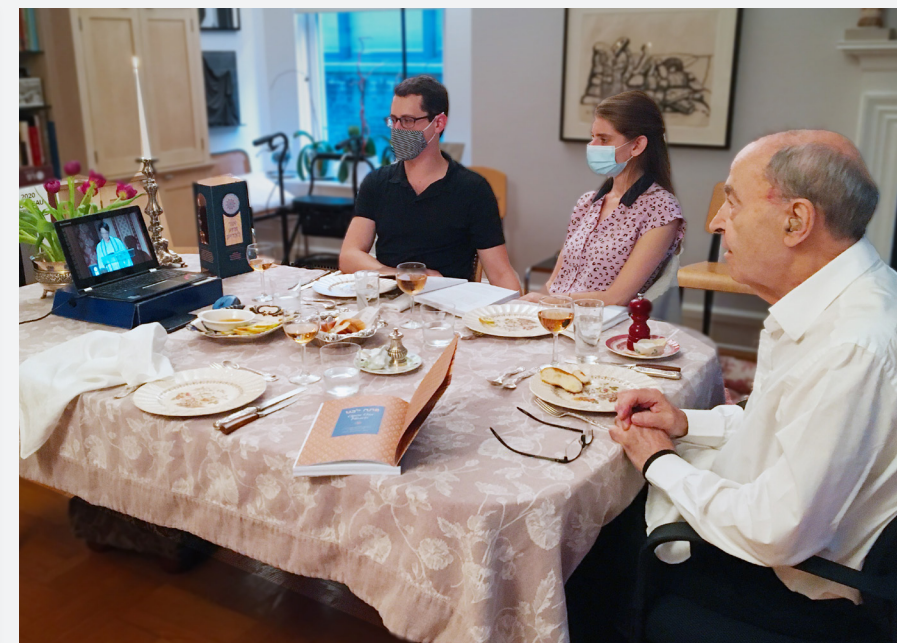

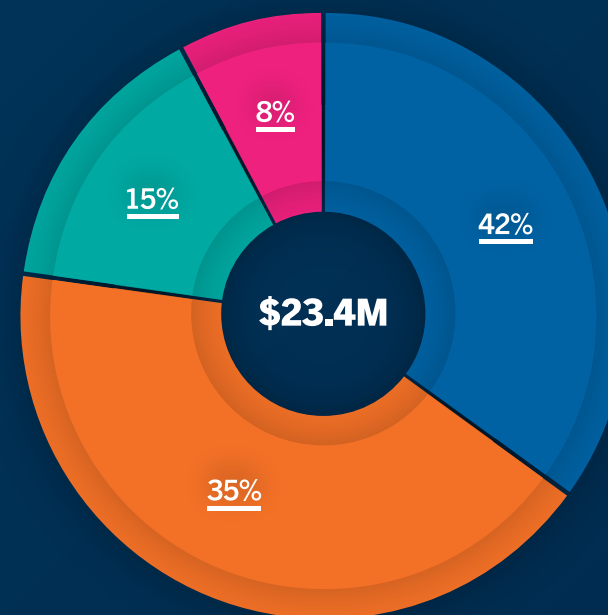

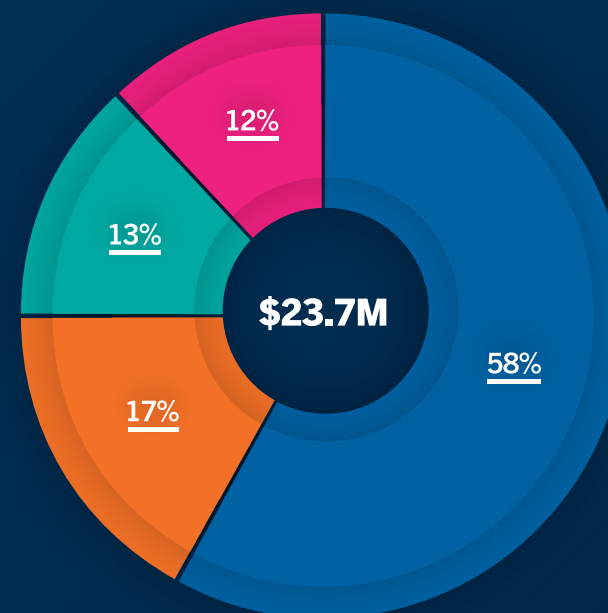
